## MONDAY, APRIL 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018, 1:30PM MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION MEETING OF THE NORVELL TOWNSHIP BOARD HELD IN THE NORVELL TOWNSHIP HALL, 106 E. COMMERCIAL ST, NORVELL MI 49263

**PRESENT:** Supervisor Johnson, Clerk Barnett, Treasurer Sauers, Trustee Johnson and Trustee Dame. The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 1:35 PM. with the pledge of allegiance.

### **New Business:**

#### **-Legal update**

The Supervisor gave an update on a lawsuit *that is going on with two groups that live down at a lake.* Residents of the township would like to have the end of the road so they can place a dock. The Supervisor would like the County to state that this part of the road is theirs and therefore the people cannot do what they want, or give it to the Township, so the Board can handle it.

#### **- Nuisance Ord.**

The Supervisor stated that he has nothing new for this. It was tabled.

#### **- Ahrens Park playground equipment**

The Supervisor thought that Trustee Johnson had come up with other types *on* (on) equipment that could be used. She stated that she really hadn't, that anything she had found wouldn't work for the park. Sauers stated that she doesn't want the Board to use wood for the playground equipment. Clerk Barnett suggested that they look at the Brooklyn park *and* that (That) what they have is nice and simple, like what the board wants. Trustee Johnson said she would call the park and see what company they went with. Sauers stated that the park needs new tables and Trustee Johnson asked her to look into it.
